ST. ANNE AFFILIATES, Rockford

The affiliates and sisters meet the second Saturday of the month. At each meeting one of the affiliates leads us in an opening prayer. We then have a sharing of events and happenings in our lives. In February, we began our new book: This is My Body by Bishop Robert Barron. We have found that reading together out loud is the best way for us to share the material. As we read, we stop to point out important facts, ask questions or explanations and comment on what we're hearing. It is rather deep material, but we are finding it interesting and challenging.

In April, we had two women from the group KFACT: Keeping Families and Communities Together. Their group statement is: Empowering Girls Isn't an Option It's a Must! Connect with Us...Expose - Engage - Empower. This group works beginning with middle school girls who are at risk. They meet as groups within the school community and then move from there to individual mentoring of girls through high school helping them to rise above their challenges and risk factors. During the summer there are special events and trips to introduce the girls to places and events they may never experience without this group. They are a non-profit, non-governmental program that depends on donations and grants to continue their work.

Each month we as a group decide to which group we want to make a donation. This month we made our donation to KFACT.

Our sharing is from the book "A Passion For Life" by Joan Chittister. Each chapter focuses upon a saint or other holy person. Last meeting we read about Simone Weil. To quote from the chapter: Simone prods us to always ask another question, to want a better life for everyone, to beware our inability to critique our own beliefs, and to remember our obligation to make good on our promises. She is an icon of the search for truth, and with a pure eye keeps her focus on the ultimate meaning of things, on the sacred in everyday life, on the mystical in the midst of the mundane. She is remembered for her personal pursuit of God. Simone describes her encounter with God as the unsuccessful attempt of two lovers to meet in two different places. "Each is there", she writes, "before the time, but each at a different place, and they wait and wait and wait". Even prayer and meditation she saw as an endless period of waiting rather than an experience of the divine". What a powerful model for us in these turbulent times.
